**1. General**

- (a) These Regulations came into force on 1 January 2024.
- (b) This qualification was first offered in 2019.

**2. Exceptional Circumstances**

In exceptional circumstances the Amo Matua, Pūhanga | Executive Dean of Engineering or delegate may approve a personal programme of study which does not conform to these Regulations.

**3. Qualification Requirements**

To qualify for the Postgraduate Certificate in Civil Engineering a student must:

- (a) be credited with a minimum of 60 points selected from courcOT in anted fr~~om~~ be admitted to the Postgraduate Certificate

- (a) qualified for the Degree of Bachelor of Engineering with Honours in an appropriate subject; or
- (b) qualified for the Degree of Bachelor of Science with Honours in an appropriate subject; or
