

A prerequisite is a course that you must take and pass before you can do another course (normally at a more advanced level).
A co-requisite is a course that must be taken at the same time (concurrently) or earlier with another specified course.

You can check to see if a course has a prerequisite or co-requisite on the Course Information page online:

Exemption from a prerequisite or co-requisite will be granted only when the Amo | Dean is satisfied that:

Either (i) sufficient material in the prerequisite or co-requisite has been covered to a comparable standard elsewhere;

Or (ii) there is clear evidence of special ability in the subject area of the proposed course.
